PRIVACY NOTICE – PARENTS/CARERS AND PARTICIPANTS

How we use children's information attending the multi sports events

We collect and use student information in line with Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

We use the 'consented' data:

- to provide a register of attendance and for a fire list in case of an emergency
- to collate emergency contact information of parents/carers
- to market Dynamic Sports Coaching activities via agreed parent or carer preferred contact details
- to market Dynamic Sports Coaching activities solely within its own marketing platforms by way of images and participant names.

All of the information provided to us is on a voluntary basis. However, if we are unable to obtain consent regarding participants' names and their family emergency contact details, then Dynamic Sports Coaching reserve the right to refuse individuals participation on the grounds of Health and Safety.

Storing of information

Dynamic Sports Coaching keeps the information on secure computer systems and also sometimes on paper.

We hold participants' details and emergency contacts until the conclusion of each respective multi sports event, after which they are safely destroyed.

Parent or carer preferred contact information and/or images and participant names may be retained for 1 year after the event for consented marketing purposes as detailed above. This time period can be extended by mutual agreement.

There are strict controls on who can see the information; we will not share data if you have advised us that you do not want it shared. Images shared on our multi-media platforms will be in the public domain via search engines and third party reproduction will be discouraged but cannot be guaranteed.

Requesting access to your personal data

Under data protection legislation, parents or carers have the right to request access to information about them that we hold although this will have been consented at the point of application to an event. To make a request for your personal information, contact Dynamic Sports Coaching's responsible persons via office.dynamicsports@gmail.com

Parents and carers also have the right to:

- object to processing of personal data that is likely to cause, or is causing, damage or distress;
- prevent processing for the purpose of direct marketing even if consent had been previously given;
- in certain circumstances, have inaccurate personal data rectified, blocked, erased or destroyed;
- their request being dealt with as soon as practical but definitely within one calendar month of its receipt.

If you have a concern about the way that we are collecting or using your personal data, you should raise your concern with us in the first instance, as all data will be via consent, or directly to the Information Commissioner's Office at <https://ico.org.uk/concerns/>.
